

Why Violence Prevention Education?

- * An average of **15** teens are killed by peers each day.
- * 33% of teens report being in a physical fight within the last **12** months.
- * 17% of teens report carrying a weapon within the last **30** days.
- * Approximately **1** in 5 female high school students report being physically and/or sexually abused by a dating partner.
- * Nearly **50%** of adult sex-offenders report committing their first crime before the age of **18**.

School-Based Violence Prevention Education

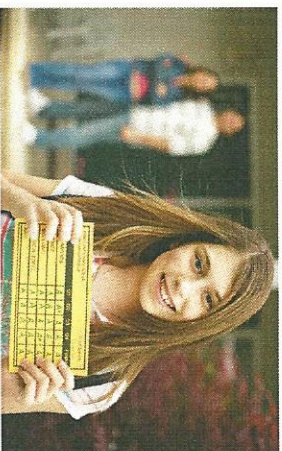


57% of teens know someone who has been *physically, sexually, or verbally abused in a dating relationship.*

Elementary-Aged Programming

- **Talking About Touch** - A personal boundaries awareness curriculum. (Possible 8-week series)
 - **Bullying** - Teaches children how to work cooperatively.
 - **Hands are not for Hitting** - Helps children understand there are better things to do than fight with others.
 - **Animal Cruelty** - Links the circle of passion between human and animals.
- ***TOFAS facilitates support groups on various topics. Just ask for more information.

* Each year over 3.3 million children live in violent homes.



Middle School Aged Programming

- **Internet Safety** - Creates awareness among young adolescence of the dangers of the internet.
- **Flirting or Hurting** - Guides adolescence on appropriate interactions.
- **Choose Respect** - Assists teens in establishing respectful communications.
- **In Touch With Teens** - Explores aspects of domestic violence and sexual assault. (2, 4-part series)
- **Love U2** - Guides adolescents in healthy communications for all their relationships. (1-7 sessions)
- **Bullying 101** - Basic tools to stop bullying in middle school.

High School Aged Programming

- **Campus Safety** - Educates teens on what to expect on their college campuses.
- **Sexual Harassment** - Enlightens students on what constitutes sexual harassment.
- **Quiet Storm Project** - Teaches about dating violence. (2 part series)
- **Dating Violence** - Helps teens recognize unhealthy relationships.
- **Break the Cycle** - Aids teens in stopping the domestic violence cycle.
- **In Touch With Teens** - Explores aspects of domestic violence and sexual assault. (2, 4-part series)
- **Love U2** - Guides adolescents in healthy communications for all their relationships.
